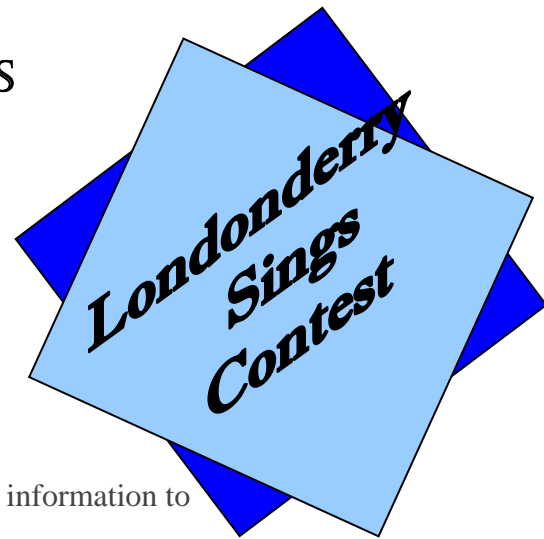


# LONDONDERRY SINGS OLD HOME DAY COMPETITION



## 1. Eligibility

- a. Participants must be between **13 and 110** years old
- b. Participants must be Londonderry Residents
- c. Professional entertainers are prohibited
- d. **Individual Participants** only, No Groups

## 2. The Initial Competition

- a. All eligible participants need to **email the following registration** information to [mary@oldhomeday.com](mailto:mary@oldhomeday.com):

**Name, Address, Age, Phone Number, email address** and **the link** to an uploaded YouTube video which is a maximum 3 minute solo a capella (no background music) video.

**DO NOT PUT ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION IN YOUR YOU TUBE VIDEO!**

- b. Registrations will be accepted anytime from July 1st to August 17th.
- c. The participant's song must be appropriate for viewing by the general public; failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- d. Members of the Old Home Day Committee will select the top twelve contestants based on Stage Presences, Singing Ability and Song Selection.
- e. All participants will be notified if they have progressed to the final round by August 15th.

## 3. The Final Competition

- a. **August 20th 2:30pm to 4pm** at the Londonderry Commons band stand.
- b. Participants will submit their song selection to the Judges for approval by August 17.
- c. Participants will sing a 5 minute (maximum) song a capella (or with cd player.)
- d. We will have sound equipment available and the ability to play music accompaniment from a phone or other personal device.

Judges will rate contestants on a scale of 1 to 5 (5 is high) on Stage Presence, Singing Ability and Song Selection. In the event of a numerical tie, the Judges will rank the participants in order, with the participant getting the most number 1 votes being selected as the winner. Judges' decisions are final.

- e. Prizes will be:

**1st Place \$100 on a debit card**

2nd Place \$75 in prizes

3rd Place \$50 in prizes

## 4. Standards of Conduct:

- a. Each participant must adhere to a standard of conduct that includes respect for other contestants, volunteers, and judges. Any use of inappropriate language and/or behavior may lead to disqualification.
- b. Inappropriate attire as deemed by the Old Home Day Committee may lead to disqualification.

**5. Approvals:** By submitting an application, the participant gives the Old Home Day Committee the rights to use pictures and videos from the audition and competition for publicity. Participants will receive no compensation.

**6. Alterations to the Rules:** The Old Home Day Committee may change or alter these rules at anytime in the best interest of the competition and its participants.
